- Important changes due to COVID-19:

- Classes are grouped according to age: 6 to 7;8 to 12;13 to 18
- Class Size is limited to **8 participants** and 2 coaches (minimum of 4 participants per class)
- There is a half-hour window in between classes to avoid clustering
- No Summer Programs at Briardale and Grantwood; Possibly in the Fall
- Virtual Summer Programs will be offered. Please register for those via Salesforce!
- No indoor instruction; classes will be cancelled due to inclement weather
